Numbers 19:2-13

A strange sacrifice

Outside the camp

The sacrificer becomes unclean and the ashes bring purity.

Especially the impurity of death.

All other sacrifices are dependent on this sacrifice.

Jesus was sacrificed: outside the camp, he became unclean, those who touch him become clean, and all other sacrifices are dependent on him.

There have been 9 Red Heifer sacrifices.

The Talmud states that the 10th will be offered by messiah.

Jesus was the 10th.

The Temple Institute has been trying to breed a Red Heifer since 1981 and they have failed over and over.

They have tried genetic modification (without success).
