Another Way to Worship

The School of the Prophets

First clearly mentioned in 2 Kings 2: Elisha is teaching the sons of the prophets.

Also, in 2 Kings 2 the students note that Elisha had succeeded Elijah as the leader of the school.

In 1 Samuel 19 we see Samuel leading a school of prophets.

In 1 Samuel 3 Eli trains Samuel in prophecy.

The Essenes trace the school from Noah through Shem to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Then through Levi, his children, Aaron, his children, Samuel, Elijah, Elisha, and ultimately to John the Baptist and the Essenes.

The Essenes called their school The Way and they trained Paul, who proclaimed before Felix in Acts 24, that he was a follower of The Way.
