Lifting up of the hands - acknowledging God's majesty, sovereignty

David (Ps. 63: 1ff) David (Ps. 141: 2)

Spreading out of the hands - indicating an openness to receive

Clapping of the hands (Ps. 47: 1)

Shouting, not singing loudly (also Ps. 47:1)
